

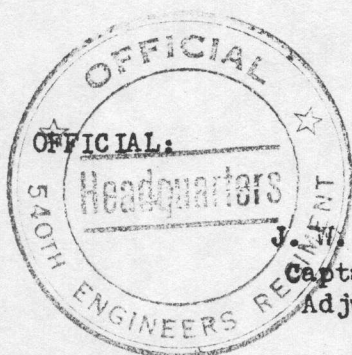

TO : Private Russell R. Thunstrom, 37164607, 2832nd Engineer Combat Battalion,
 APO 758, U. S. Army.

Under the provisions of AR 600-45, you are hereby awarded the Silver Star
 with the accompanying citation:

RUSSELL R. THUNSTROM, 37164607, Private, 2832nd Engineer Combat Battalion,
 for gallantry in action on 1 January 1945 in France. During an attack on his
 battalion headquarters, Private THUNSTROM, although armed with only an M-1
 rifle, engaged the enemy in a fire fight. By swiftly alternating his position
 he was able to successfully evade the hostile fire while maintaining an almost
 continuous fire of his own which inflicted heavy casualties on the enemy and
 finally caused them to retreat from all near approaches to the building which
 was being utilized by the battalion as its command post. Shortly thereafter,
 Private THUNSTROM volunteered to accompany a staff officer in an effort to contact
 a higher headquarters for the purpose of informing them of the enemy penetration.
 Having proceeded approximately 300 yards, they were fired upon by an enemy patrol.
 Private THUNSTROM crossed an open intersection and, while in an exposed position,
